Its convenient location, close to Universal, NBC, and Disney studios, makes it a smart budget choice for families and business travelers. All 255 rooms and suites were updated recently and feature contemporary furnishings and splashes of color. Units include free Internet access, cable TV, coffeemakers and private balconies. The KidSuites, two-bedded rooms converted for families, have bunk beds, flat-panel TVs, game tables, refrigerators, and video games.
